(MUSIC #24 — "SOMETHING EXTRA" — REPRISE)

(On applause, CONTESTANTS exits.)

FRANKIE. (cont.) Ladies and gentlemen, tonight is only the beginning for Miss Glamouresse [UPCOMING YEAR], but it's the beginning of the end for Miss Glamouresse [CURRENT YEAR]

Ladies and gentlemen, Miss Glamouresse, [CURRENT YEAR],

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(TAWNY-JO is played by the actor who portrayed the winner of the "Girlfriend Award" [either MISS WEST COAST or MISS INDUSTRIAL NORTHEAST]. SHE is revealed Upstage Center in silhouette and as the lights come up we see SHE has developed quite a full figure. An exuberant good-time gal, TAWNY-JO is wearing the "MISS GLAMOURESSE" banner and crown.)

FRANKIE. Well, Tawny-Jo, it looks like you had quite a year!

TAWNY-JO. Indeed I did, Frankie. I got so much love from all those wonderful people this year. They gave me friendship and testimonial dinners and breakfasts and lunches and buffets. Thanks to them, I discovered the true size of my natural beauty and, Frankie, Bo Derek may be a ten but I'm an eighteen!

FRANKIE. You certainly are, Tawny-Jo. Inspiring — that's what I call it. And I guess the folks at Glamouresse feel the same way. Because tonight, in your honor, they are introducing a brand new product for women just as big and beautiful as you are.

(MUSIC #25 — SPOKESMODEL #7)
